

## A CHART OF THE SPANISH PRONOUNS

SUBJECT PRONOUN	DIRECT OBJECT	INDIRECT OBJECT	POSSESSIVE	REFLEXIVE	PREPOSITIONAL	RECIPROCAL
Yo	me	me	mi	me	mí	-
Tú	te	te	tu	te	ti	-
Él	lo	le	su	se	él	-
Ella	la	le	su	se	ella	-
Usted	lo, la	le	su	se	usted	-
Nosotros	nos	nos	nuestro	nos	nosotros	nos
Ellos	los	les	su	se	ellos	se
Ellas	las	les	su	se	ellas	se
Ustedes	los, las	les	su	se	ustedes	se

- Remember that with [Double Object pronouns](#), the Indirect Object pronouns *le* and *les* change to *se* when combined with the Direct Object pronouns *lo*, *la*, *los*, and *las*.
- Remember that the Possessive pronouns need to agree in number with the possessed object; and in the case of the *Nosotros* form, the pronouns must agree in both number *and* gender.
